Join us for the Annual **Carroll County Souper Bowl** on **November 8, 2024**, at **Berryville Bobcat Football Stadium**. Contestants may begin setting up at 5:30 p.m. Purchase of chili sampling bowls will be sold for \$5 to the public, with proceeds benefiting on an equal basis Kiwanis, and an organization/department at both the Berryville and Green Forest School Districts.

Contestant Entry Fees: Individual \$50 / Business or Organization \$100 / Challenge Match additional \$10
Businesses or organization will receive a logoed yard sign for display at the event.

CONTEST RULES

1. Contestants must pre-register; no walk-ups will be accepted for contest judgement.
2. Registration deadline 4:00 p.m. November 6th, 2024
3. Each Chili entry fee entitles one person to attend the football game, but not the entire team—the remaining team members must purchase a game ticket.
4. Contestants must sign in at the registration table upon arrival.
5. Chili must be prepared in advance and placed at their designated station (table) at the event.
6. All ingredients are OK to use, no restrictions. If you are using ingredients people may be allergic to (MSG, peanut oil, etc.), please indicate those items by making a sign to be posted at your station.
7. Contestants are responsible for supplying all their own serving and cooking utensils, table decorations and warming device. Contestants may decorate their section of the table area.
8. Specialty condiments/toppings are not allowed for judging process; however, you may make them available at your station for the Public.
9. Each chef will be able to prepare the chili cup serving for judging. Runners will receive the cup and serve it to the judges.
10. Judging will be performed at a distance away from the chefs and the competition. No signage, handouts, recipe cards are to be displayed or provided to any of the judges.
11. Contestants are responsible for the clean-up of their station

We encourage contestants to come up with clever team names and names for their chili.

Organizers will provide common chili condiments such as: crackers, shredded cheese, sour cream, diced onions, jalapenos, salt, and pepper.

Organizers will provide eating utensils such as: bowls, spoons, and napkins. Sample bowls will be sold for \$5 to the Public for tasting of the various chilis.

Judging will begin at approximately 6:30 p.m. with the exact starting time being announced by the Souper Bowl Officials. Contestants are asked to provide 6-8 quarts of chili for the public and voting for the People's Choice Award. One pint (16 ounces) of chili is required to submit for the judging.

The chili prepared for the judges must be the same served to the public.

Each chili entered will be assigned a number by the judging committee, and each contestant is responsible for turning in his or her chili with that number.

Judges will evaluate the best overall chili based on the following criteria:

* Appearance * Aroma * Flavor * Texture * Originality

The two Judging categories for the awards are as follows:

- Best Overall will be awarded as the Grand Champion
- People's Choice Award Winner

The winners of these categories will receive a Souper Bowl Trophy and a Souper Bowl apron.

The People's Choice Award will be based on votes submitted by the Public. One dollar (\$1) will represent one vote.

Best Chili Award will be determined by the Judging Committee. The People's Choice Award is determined by the public.

Organizers will provide the contestants with a container to collect their "People's Choice Award" votes.

Awards will be presented on the field between the 3rd/4th Quarter break during the football game.

Event will be held rain or shine.

Event staff will dispose of any left-over items after the close of the event.
